

Why do we care about SWD?



Drosophila suzukii

many generations per year

With as many as 13 generations per season, and the ability for the female to lay up to 300 eggs each, the potential population size of *D. suzukii* is huge

long migration ability

Recently, studies of the dispersal **ability** of *D. suzukii* over extended periods have demonstrated that *D. suzukii* flies are **able** to fly up to 9000 m away from the marking point over their entire lifetimes and that seasonal breezes likely facilitate **long**-distance movement

daily dispersal ability

D. suzukii is able to perform daily movement between the crop and the surrounding vegetation

pesticide resistance

D. suzukii is developing genetic resistance towards chemicals





The sterile insect technique (SIT), incompatible insect technique (IIT) or a combination of the two could be used to suppress populations. Male are sterilised either by the application of irradiation or (trans)infection with Wolbachia, or both, and then released into the target population to sterilise the wild females






