
NARBA Executive Council Officers Report

NARBA offered members access to a free RCA Trellis Webinar hosted by the University of Arkansas System Division of Agriculture Research and Extension. Members can now view a video recording of the the webinar below. Please note that you must be logged into your Account Manager to view this video.

Movable trellising systems like the Rotating Cross-arm trellis, or RCA, can help combat extreme weather impacts on blackberry production and can modify the plant canopy such that fruit quality is improved and pest pressure is reduced. Join us for a weblinar with researchers Dr. Amanda McWhirt and Aaron Cato from the University of Arkansas to learn more about moveable trellis management for blackberry, including crop management, recommendations for novel training methods that reduce labor, advice on adjusting spray volumes, research on trellis economics and more. This webinar will provide an opportunity to virtually see movable trellises in action and learn from over 5 years of research.


